

Expectations for Ph.D. Students Receiving Stipends: Ph.D. students receiving stipends are required to expend 100% of their professional effort on their doctoral training. Although a limited amount of volunteer or other unpaid effort outside of their graduate training is allowed as long as (i) this effort is approved by the student's advisor, program director and the Associate Dean for Graduate Education, and (ii) this effort does not interfere with satisfactory academic progress. Ph.D. students receiving stipends are strictly forbidden from being paid for effort outside of their graduate training.
