Please note only **full time** faculty are eligible for this award. All nominations will be reviewed by a committee comprised of former winners of this award. A panel including the President of MCV Physicians, the Dean of the School of Medicine and the Sr. Associate Dean of Faculty Affairs, SOM will also review the nominations to verify that the nominees are in good standing with regard to professionalism and citizenship.
